



HARNESS INSTALLATION PARTS




- A Harness x 1

- C Gray Clips x 4


NOTICE: This Quick Reference Guide demonstrates the correct procedure for installing the backpack harness.

ASSEMBLY

1. Unpack the harness and locate the four gray clips required for installation. The clips secure the harness to the backpack.
2. Slide the top strap loop into one of the two slots located below the backpack handle. Then pull the loop through the slot. See Fig. 1.



3. Insert the gray clip through the loop. Pull down on the strap to seat it into the slot on the handle. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for the other side. See Fig. 2.




4. There are three ways to install the lower part of the harness to the backpack. Choose the option that provides the most comfortable fit:

OPTION 1 (Recommended): Fasten the lower part of the harness to the side of the backpack:

- a. Locate the lower straps on both sides of the harness.
- b. For each strap, pull the loop through the side slots on the backpack and insert the gray clip through the loop.
- c. Pull each strap to seat the gray clip against the back of the backpack. See Fig. 3.



OPTION 2: Fasten the lower part of the harness to the bottom of the backpack:

- a. Locate the lower straps on both sides of the harness.
- b. For each strap, pull the loop through the lower slots on the backpack and insert the gray clip through the loop.
- c. Pull each strap to seat the gray clip against the back of the backpack. See Fig. 4.



OPTION 3: Fasten the lower part of the harness to the foot stand of the backpack (gray clips are not required for this option):

- a. Locate the lower straps on both sides of the harness.
- b. Loop each strap around the foot stand and guide it through the strap adjuster to tighten. See Fig. 5.

5. Refer to the instruction manual for filling and operating the backpack sprayer.


6. Place the sprayer on your back, then fasten the waist belt and chest strap to secure it in place. See Fig. 6.






